EMPIRE | KVCR Provides Online Resources With A New Educational Television Schedule for At-Home-Learning

April 8, 2020 - As schools in Riverside and San Bernardino counties suspend classes to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, your local PBS and NPR member station KVCR follows in unison with other PBS stations throughout California to support the At-Home Learning project for our students here in our Inland Empire region. Beginning March 23, we revamped our weekday television schedule of educational programs. In partnership with the San Bernardino and Riverside County Unified School Districts, we are now broadcasting curriculum-based TV shows that students, teachers and the general



public can access from home. The county's educational offices are working diligently to create and provide supplemental educational materials for the upper grade levels.

THE NEW DAY TIME SCHEDULE: The new 6:00am to 6:00pm schedule includes curriculum-based programs for pre-K to 12th grade.

6:00am to 9:00am - Pre K-3rd includes: *Nature Cat* (Science/Nature); *Curious George* (Math/Engineering); *Peg+Cat* (Math); *Daniel Tiger* (Social Science); *Sesame Street* (Basic Reading); and *Wild Kratts* (Natural Science).

9:00am to 12:00 noon – Grades 9th – 12th Programs consist of a variety of shows including **NOVA**; **American Experience** and **Masterpiece**.

Noon to 3:00pm - Grades 4th - 8th Programs including *History Detectives* and Huell Howser's *California Missions*; and *Nature*.

4th – 12th grade programming covers various subjects including English, language arts, social studies, science, and math.

The adult learning programs for all ages will round out the TV programming schedule from 3:00pm – 6:00pm that will include cooking, crafting, painting and woodworking.
